Joshua: “Strong and Courageous”
Week 12: Joshua 24 | August 20, 2023

1. ICEBREAKER: As summer comes to a close, what’s one aspect of the fall season you’re looking forward to?
2. These are Joshua’s last words to God’s people before he dies. What sticks out to you from these verses as especially helpful for our lives today? *Leader Tip: No exact right answer here*
3. On what basis are we called to fear the Lord and worship him as verse 14 commands? *Leader Tip: Trace the “Now therefore” from v.14 to the prior verses*
4. Israel is called to worship and serve God in spite of their inability to do so on their own? How have you felt this tension in your life? Where do you find hope in this “impossible” command? What makes it possible?
5. God is described in this passage as being “jealous.” What does that mean? What practical implications should this have on our lives? Do you ever think about God this way?
6. Why is the mention of Joseph’s bones at the end of the chapter significant? In other words, why is it important to remember the history of God’s people and our place in it? How should that change our lives today?
7. As we conclude our summer in Joshua, how has God used this book to change your life? How has it challenged and/or strengthened your faith? Who could you share that with this week?
