

Life Group Questions Joshua: "Strong and Courageous" Week 11: Joshua 23 | August 23, 2023

ICEBREAKER: Share a positive memory from the summer so far. Consider family trips, personal highlights, etc. Spend a brief moment in prayer, thanking God for his good gifts this summer.

- Of the four-generation analogy Gary opened with, where do you think you best fit in?
 a. Why might it be practically important for us today to consider where we fit in that?
- 2. In v. 3, Joshua begins his farewell speech by reinforcing that God has acted for Israel's sake and that He has fought for them.
 - a. When has God acted for your sake? When has God fought for you?
 - b. Why is it practically important to remind ourselves of these things?
- What does Joshua tell the next generation to do in v. 8?
 a. In what practical ways do you "cling to God?"
- 4. Gary ended with discussing the difference between a "Christian" and a "disciple." Do you see a difference? If there is one, *should* there be one? What might distinguish the two?
- 5. Can you think of someone you'd say has discipled you? Can you think of others you've discipled? Why is this relationship so important?
- 6. What would you say to someone claiming that Joshua 23:12 forbids interracial marriages between two Christians today? *Leader Tip: point to the different ways w/ in book of Joshua God has shown mercy to Canaanites (Rahab, Gibeonites, etc.) not a race issue but a faith issue*
