- 1. Read Luke 1:5-25 together. Pull out the key facts:
 - · Who is involved?
 - · What happened?
 - Where did it happened?
 - What were others thinking?
- 2. How did God demonstrate in the lives of Zechariah and Elizabeth that he is sovereign? (discuss the meaning of 'sovereign')
- 3. How have you seen signs of God's sovereignty in your lives?
- 4. When have you doubted the reality of God's wonderful provision for you? What caused that doubt?
- 5. What long-term frustration can you identify in your life that needs to be entrusted to God? (take time to pray for one another after they share or do so at the end)
- 6. Read Luke 1:67-79. What are the themes in Zechariah's song?
- 7. What can parents learn from Zechariah about passing on faith to their children?
- 8. What idea from Zechariah's song would you most like to communicate to your family this week?
