1. ICEBREAKER: If you're married, share a funny memory from your wedding day or maybe your first few years of marriage.
 - a. If you could go back in time to speak with that past version of yourself, what are 1-2 pieces of advice would you give?
2. If you have personal experience with divorce (either yourself or your parents), that you're comfortable sharing, what was that like? What has God taught you since that?
3. It's important for others, especially in this group, to frequently hear us speaking positively about our spouse instead of complaining about them. Let's take turns sharing a few reasons why we love our spouse.
4. Read Matthew 5:37 and James 5:12.
 - a. Have you noticed our culture's fickleness lately? Why do you think we struggle to keep our word or commit to things/churches/plans/each other, etc.?
5. After 4 weeks in to our Summer on the Mount series, spend a few minutes reviewing the passages we've covered so far. Jot down and share a few things God has taught you so far through the first 37 verses of Matthew 5.
