Core Value # 4: Know, Grow, Multiply: "The HOW of the WHO" 1 Sam. 3:1-19, 1 Sam. 22:1-2, 2 Sam. 23:13-17 || October 2, 2022

- 1. If a non-believing friend asked you, "How do you *know* that you know Jesus?" what would you say?
 - a. In what ways is actually knowing Jesus different from knowing about Jesus?
- 2. Of the 3 environments we covered Sunday and listed below, which one do you see the most evidence of in your life right now? Which one do you see the most room for growth right now? It might be helpful for some in the group to summarize each one in their own words.
 - a. Know
 - b. Grow
 - c. Multiply
- 3. On Sunday, Steven said, "Many Christians, pastors, and even churches default to GROW without ever advancing to MULTIPLY." Do you agree? Why or why not?
 - a. How does that experience compare/contrast with Jesus' call to **make disciples** in Matthew 28:19?
- 4. We discussed 2 truths found in 1 Samuel 3 as it pertains to know, grow multiply on Sunday. Can someone recap those quickly?
 - a. You can K-G-M in difficult seasons of life.
 - b. You can K-G-M even if you've blown it.
 - c. Of those two truths, which one is most encouraging to you and why?
- 5. Remember the type of men who came to serve under David's command in 1 Samuel 22:2. Have someone share the 3 ways the Bible describes them.
 - a. We then said, "Anyone can get in on this (K-G-M)!
 - b. What's one *practical* thing that might need to change in your life to fully embrace that statement?
- 6. Of the 3 core values we've covered in this series (Christ-centered, outward-focused, family of faith), which do you see the most evidence of in your life right now?
 - a. In which would you like to see more growth over the last 90 days of 2022?
 - b. What might one practical step look like in that pursuit?
 - c. Who can you share that step/plan with for encouragement and accountability along the way?
