- 1. ICEBREAKER: This past Sunday was Mother's Day how would you describe your mom in just a few words? How did she, through success and/or failure, point you to Jesus? Spend a moment here thanking God for the gift of Moms before moving on to the next question.
- 2. If someone were to ask you what verse 4 means when God says, 'the righteous shall live by faith" what would you say?
- 3. So far through Habakkuk 1 ans 2, what has Habakkuk taught us about the nature of God?
- 4. In chaos, in what ways are you tempted to rely on yourself?
- 5. In chaos, in what ways are you tempted to rely on religion?
- 6. In chaos, what *practical* ways can we rely on the righteousness that comes from *outside* us?
- 6. Part of what it means to live by faith (Habakkuk 2:4), is for Jesus followers to "not shrink back" (Hebrews 10:38). In what ways do you feel God calling Jesus followers to not shrink back in general? What about you as a Jesus follower in particular?
