Habakkuk: Faith + Trust in Chaos

Hab. 2:2-5, Romans 1:16-17, Gal. 3:10-11, Hebrews 10:37-38

Habakkuk 2:2-5 | May 14, 2023

1. ICEBREAKER: This past Sunday was Mother's Day - how would you describe your mom in just a few words? How did she, through success and/or failure, point you to Jesus? Spend a moment here thanking God for the gift of Moms before moving on to the next question.
2. If someone were to ask you what verse 4 means when God says, 'the righteous shall live by faith' what would you say?
3. So far through Habakkuk 1 and 2, what has Habakkuk taught us about the nature of God?
4. In chaos, in what ways are you tempted to rely on yourself?
5. In chaos, in what ways are you tempted to rely on religion?
6. In chaos, what *practical* ways can we rely on the righteousness that comes from *outside* us?
6. Part of what it means to live by faith (Habakkuk 2:4), is for Jesus followers to "not shrink back" (Hebrews 10:38). In what ways do you feel God calling Jesus followers to not shrink back in general? What about you as a Jesus follower in particular?
