

Life Group Questions Core Value #3: Family of Faith Mark 2:1-12 || September 25, 2022

Ice-Breaker: If you had a family reunion with all your relatives past and present in attendance, who would be voted the most beloved family member and the most "unusual" (that's a nice way to say it) family member? Tell us about them.

1) What stood out from Sunday's message—did anything encourage, inspire, or challenge you? What questions do you have?

2) Read Mark 2:1-12. If you had the following people over for dinner after the events from Mark 2 (one of the individuals carrying the paralyzed man, a teacher of the law, and a person who simply wanted to hear Jesus teach), how would each person describe the scene?

3) Why was Jesus accused of blasphemy, and why did Jesus heal the paralyzed man?

4) What does this story tell you is the difference between true spirituality and counterfeit spirituality?

5) What are the healthy habits of an effective life group? On a scale of 1-10 (1=easy; 10=difficult), what score would the average Life Group in America get according to those habits?

6) What's one strength our group has, and what's one area we could improve?

7) What's one way you can contribute to making our group stronger and more of a family?
