

Life Group Questions Expanding our view: Week 3 | Luke 11:5-13 | Feb 25, 2024

<u>Ice Breaker</u>: When your children have wanted something from you, perhaps at Christmas or on their birthday, but were afraid you might say "no," what did they do to increase their chances of getting a yes? (or maybe you have had this experience as a teen and would like to share?)

Read Luke 11:5-13

- 1. Do you ever feel as though you're bugging God with your prayers?
- 2. Please share an example of when you have prayed persistently and God has answered.
- 3. When have you given up praying about something that required a little more persistence?
- 4. Parables are brief true-to-life stories that teach a spiritual truth, one central message. This parable has at least two. What are they?
- 5. How do verses 11-13 clarify the intent of verses 9-10?
- 6. Read Mark 12:30. How can we encourage one another in our love for God? What impact does our prayer life have on our loving God as he commands in His Word?
- 7. Read John 14:15 and John 15:7. How can we *consistently* obey to receive this promise?
- 8. In light of the Churches' marching orders found in Matthew 28:18-20 and how God sees our role in 2 Corinthians 6:1-2, how should we be praying? Why?
 - Take time to pray together.
 - Encourage all to continue utilizing the *40 Days of Prayer Verse Packs*. Day 11 is Monday, Feb 26. Have group members reflect on the verse each day and pray the Faith Church prayer request listed.
