

Life Group Questions The Sins of Suburbia | Week 4: Family Matthew 12:46-50 || October 30, 2022

Ice-Breaker: Tell us about one of the following people in your extended family (avoid sharing about anyone in the room unless it's positive): the "crazy uncle," the hugger, the mysterious, the loud talker, the quiet talker, the picky eater, etc. Despite their unique trait, what is something you appreciate about him/her?

1) What stood out from Steven's message that challenged you, intrigued you, or that you'd like to discuss?

2) The **Big Idea** from the message is that "devotion to family must not supersede devotion to God." What are common ways families struggle with this? Do you resonate with one or more?

3) Who came to find Jesus in verse 46? Based on the context of the chapter, what is a possible reason they sought to get his attention? What do we learn about **Jesus' desire for us** from his response in verse 50?

4) What special bonds does the family of God have that earthly families do not?

5) What are the **benefits of becoming a church member**? (i.e., Why bother?)

6) Steven concluded by asking five application questions. Which challenged you the most?

- a) Will you reject the cultural pressure to find your identity in the success of your kids? (comparison)
- b) Will you order your family life in such a way so that you can do the Father's will together? (busyness)
- c) Will you sacrifice some "family" time to be an outward-focused family through biblical hospitality? (privacy)
- d) What would you do if your children came to you one day denying the truth?
- e) Will you consider joining this family of faith? (membership class Nov 20)
