Core Value # 1: Christ-Centered
Mark 10:17-22 || September 11, 202

Ice-Breaker: We're at the start of a new series at Faith Church and we want to set some spiritual goals. Over the next 4 weeks, how do you want to grow more like Jesus? *Encourage people to write their goals down to re-visit at the end of this 14 week stretch.*****

- 1.) How would you describe to a friend what a Christ-centered life looks like?
- 2.) On what did your life *used* to be centered before you started living a Christ-centered life?
- 3.) Read Mark 10:17-22. We categorized this young man as living a “Christ-adjacent” life instead of a Christ-centered life.
 - a. What evidence do you see for that claim in the text?
- 4.) For this young man, money was what he chose to follow instead of Jesus.
 - a. What are some common things in today’s culture that people choose to follow instead of Jesus?
 - b. What would you be tempted to follow instead of Jesus?
- 5.) This young man gets so much right in his approach to Jesus. What does he do right that we could learn from?
 - a. Why do you think works righteousness is such a common pitfall for people in their pursuit of Jesus? How can we help remind one another of the truth of the Gospel?
- 6.) If you were to take one step over the next 4 weeks to live a more Christ-centered life, what would that *practically* look like?
