Mark 14:1-11 “Do What You Can”
October 15, 2021

1. ICEBREAKER: Share about a time when you were physically lost somewhere. What happened? Was it more funny or lonely? If you have kids, have you ever left (or almost left) a kid somewhere?
2. Who’s the most impressive Jesus follower you know? What about that person do you find yourself admiring?
3. Mary didn’t care about social or cultural concerns when she worshipped Jesus. What could it practically look like to follow her example in that way?
4. Circle back to your answer to #2. How can we sometimes be intimidated by the faith of people like that?
 - a. In v. 8, Jesus applauds Mary for “doing what she could.” How do these words of encouragement from Jesus help us fight the comparison game with other Jesus followers?
5. What’s the balance between practical, responsible stewardship and radical, extravagant giving?
 - a. How do we avoid using the former as an excuse to not do the latter?
6. In what ways today are we tempted to look for what we can get from Jesus instead of worshipping Jesus because He’s worthy?
7. *****Close in prayer – consider splitting up in men and women to share more openly how you can pray for one another.*****
