
Stephen Weinberg: Nobel Prize Winning Physicist




The Expansion of the Universe






The Human Brain



- Romans 2:14-15





Tacitus: 115 AD

• Christus, from whom the name had its origin, suffered the extreme penalty during the reign of Tiberius at the hands of one of our procurators, Pontius Pilatus, and a most mischievous superstition, thus checked for the moment, again broke out not only in Judea, . . . but even in Rome.

Josephus Antiquities (AD 37-100)



 At this time there was a wise man who was called Jesus. His conduct was good and he was known to be virtuous. And many people from among the Jews and the other nations became his disciples. Pilate condemned him to be crucified and to die. But those who became his disciples did not abandon his discipleship. They reported that he had appeared to them three days after his crucifixion, and there he was alive; accordingly he was perhaps the Messiah, concerning whom the prophets have recounted wonders.


Nazareth Decree Emperor Claudius (41-54 AD)



 It is my decision [concerning] graves and tombs whoever has made them for the religious observances of parents, or children, or household members --that these remain undisturbed forever..... You are absolutely not to allow anyone to move [those who have been entombed. if [someone does], I wish that [violator] to suffer capital punishment under the title of tomb-breaker.

- Jesus was raised from the dead??




Implications
