2 things needed to be pure in heart:

#1 we need a single, undivided, heart

To be pure in heart means our devotion is undivided. It means we are open before God, nothing is hidden.

2 things needed to be pure in heart:

#2 we need a desire to be cleansed

In order to have a pure heart, we must first realize we have an impure one.

“Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. The light of the body is the eye: if therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eye is evil, your whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness.” Matthew 6:21-23
