Devotional:

As we come near to the end of this series in the Psalms we read Psalm 110. It's a short powerful Psalm that talks about the true reality we all live in (whether we know it or not) which is that Jesus is the true King over all the world taking his rightful place in the line of the Old Testament King David. We are living in the times when God is bringing all things to their rightful end under the rule and authority of Jesus. This Psalm is the most quoted Psalm in the New Testament because the early church leaders were teaching their newly converted Christians (both Jews and Gentiles) that the correct order of life was that Jesus is King, Jesus is David's promised descendant, and Jesus reigns now and forever. We don't always see this, and we certainly don't always feel this. We see evil, corruption, selfish governments and leaders all around us. We see evil and corruption in our own hearts and lives. But the correctly ordered life knows, that Jesus is King eternal both now and always. When we shift our perspective to really see that, then we can live lives that actually make sense. We can live lives of hope and joy and peace despite all that is going on around us because we see the world correctly. We see the true order of life. Jesus reigns on high and we are citizens in his kingdom and it is a kingdom that has no end.
