## 1. The War for Holiness

The Holy Spirit fights what the flesh wants to protect. There is an internal war in every believer, and while we may be "saved," we often live "stuck" or "powerless" because we try to beat sin and lack of consistency in our own strength instead of surrendering to His power.

## 2. Produced, Not Manufactured

The Holy Spirit produces what you cannot manufacture on your own. Fruit—love, joy, peace—is the evidence that the Spirit is at work; you can perform for people or get religious, but you cannot become like Jesus apart from the Spirit of Jesus.

## 3. The Daily Yielding

The Holy Spirit fills people who keep yielding to Him. The Spirit-filled life isn't a one-time emotional event or a "weird" experience; it is a daily posture of asking, seeking, and knocking to live under His influence rather than our own.

## 4. Under the Influence: Five Evidences

Just as being "under the influence" of wine changes a person's nature, being filled with the Spirit redirects our natural traits for God's glory:

- The Lover: Spirit-filled love is sacrificial, steady, and shows up when it's hard.
- The Laugher: He produces a joy and peace that the world cannot give.
- The Truth Teller: He gives us a "filter" of truth and the power to be a bold witness.
- The Sleeper: He provides a comfort and peace that guards our minds.
- The Fighter: He redirects our aggression away from people and toward the fight against sin and for holiness.

**Call to Action:** Stop trying to "clean up" in your own strength. This week, practice the posture of Asking, Seeking, and Knocking: "Father, fill me with your Spirit so I can live with the power of Jesus today."
