Abraham for all nations.

"I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." Genesis 12:3

"Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?" Genesis 18:18 (also see Genesis 22:18; 26:4)

His glory for all nations.

"Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!" 1 Chronicles 16:24 (also see Psalm 96:3)

The Lord for all nations.

"All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you." Psalm 22:27 (also see Psalm 27:11; 82:8; 86:9)

His praise in all nations.

"Praise the Lord, all nations! Extol him, all peoples!" Psalm 117:1

His house for all nations.

"It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and shall be lifted up above the hills; and all the nations shall flow to it." Isaiah 2:2

His house of prayer for all nations.

"These I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." Isaiah 56:7 (also see Isaiah 11:1; 62:2; 66:8; Jeremiah 26:2; 27:7; 33:9)

Treasures from all nations.

"And I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with glory, says the Lord of hosts." Haggai 2:7

The gospel for all nations.

"And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." Matthew 24:14 (see Mark 13:10.)

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19

Prayer from all nations.

"And he was teaching them and saying to them, 'Is it not written, "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations"? But you have made it a den of robbers.'" Mark 11:17

Repentance and forgiveness for all nations.

"And that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem." Luke 24:47

Witness to all nations.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8

Blessings to all nations.

"And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying 'In you shall all the nations be blessed.'" Galatians 3:8

Ransomed from all nations.

"And they sang a new song, saying, 'Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.'" Revelation 5:9

Ruling all nations.

"She gave birth to a male child, one who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, but her child was caught up to God and to his throne." Revelation 12:5

Worship from all nations.

"Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed." Revelation 15:4
