



## How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps. You can use this study guide with your small group, your family, or on your own.

#### Main Idea

Without Christ, there is no such thing as a pure heart.

### **Key Questions:**

- What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- How would you describe the current state of your heart?
- What steps do you need to take to create a permanent culture of purity in your family?

Optional Questions: If needed, include one or more of these scriptures and questions to extend your conversation.

- With your Bible or YouVersion, read and discuss Ephesians 4:18-19, Psalm 119:9-10, 1 Samuel 16:7, and Ezekiel 36:26.
- What impurities have you allowed into your family? How have they affected your family?
- How have you experienced outward submission and inward rebellion in your life or in your family?
- "Anything less than perfect purity is impurity." How does that statement make you feel about yourself and your family?
- What safeguards do you have in place to help you maintain purity in your life and in the life of your family?
- How could creating a permanent culture of purity change your life and the life of your family?

#### **Next Steps:**

What's one thing you will do this week to help your home pursue a permanent culture of purity?
