Sermon Notes

Big Idea: When the people of God courageously follow the plan of God, they begin to walk in the fullness of His promises. This truth is illustrated most powerfully in the book of Joshua, as this 'next-up' leader prepares God's people to step into and occupy the Promised Land after 40 years of wandering. Are you ready to step into your promised life? It's time to take new ground!

Take New Ground:

- <u>Identify</u> your next, right step.
- Prayerfully make a plan.
- **Share** that plan with others.
- Courageously move forward.

- Your <u>Treasure</u>

- **4)** Read Joshua 24:14-15. What's your response to, "choose this day whom you will serve?" How are you doing at serving/worshiping the Lord with your Time, your Talents, and your Treasure?
- **5)** Do you agree that *Devotion to Jesus is the place where the human heart is most satisfied?* Explain. What's it like for you to experience that kind of satisfaction?
