## Discussion Questions

- 1) What impacted you the most from this week's message? Encouraged you? Challenged you?
- 2) C.S. Lewis said, "Pain is God's megaphone to speak to a deaf world." How has this been true in your life? What need (or pain) is God using in your life these days to draw you to Himself?
- 3) Read Luke 18:38-43. Jesus asked Bartimaeus, "What do you want me to do for you?" If Jesus asked you that question right now, what be your answer?
- 4) Read Luke 19:1-10. In v5, Jesus looks up and addresses Zacchaeus by name. What does this tell us about Jesus? What does it tell us about Jesus' relationship to Zacchaeus?
- 5) What does Zacchaeus' response to Jesus teach us? Does his response to others, "all who saw it" (v7), teach us anything?
- 6) Which of these do you need to be better at in your own life as it relates to loving like Jesus this week – being more present, being more accepting, or being more invested?
