- 4) Read 1 Peter 2:9-10. Do you view yourself and your fellow Christians as a Royal Priesthood? How often to you ponder the fact that your church is called to be God's Possession? Explain.
- 5) When's the last time you shared with someone the *night-and-day* difference God has made in your life?
- 6) Read 1 Peter 2:11-12. Ask God for strength to choose holiness in the midst of being ridiculed for your faith. Amen.
