

Hangry "Faith when Frustrated"

Sermon Notes

Big Idea: Faith is for when you are frustrated. When your sight is spent, and what you see gives you no hope - that's when faith is needed most. The Christian life is impossible without faith, and it's still difficult with faith. Nevertheless, *the righteous shall live by faith.*

Habakkuk 2:1-3 (ESV)

The Vision:

- The Kingdom of God is Real
- The Bible is the Handbook for Life
- Devotion to Jesus is the Place where the Human Heart is Most Satisfied

Habakkuk 2:4-5 (ESV)

Faith vs. Sight

Sight: I'll believe it when I see it. Faith: I'll believe it until I see it.

Faith when Frustrated:

- Faith is trusting what you see in the Word until you see it in the world.
- Faith is trusting what God says while waiting to see what God does.
- Faith resists just getting frustrated with God, and brings your frustration to God.
- Faith is always trusting a God that you don't always understand.
- Faith values your relationship with God more than the resolution to your problem.

- **5)** Of the five truths presented in the *Faith when Frustrated* list, which one challenges you the most and why?
