**God wants us to be honorable.
He cannot honor us until we learn to honor others.**

Deuteronomy 21:18-21 / Ephesians 6:1-4 / Luke 2:51 / Proverbs 30:11-17

A parent's job is to set up our children to walk in the promise.

How to bring Honor back to the Home:

- **Children in the Home: Submission & Obedience**
- **Adult Children: Respect & Gratitude & Forgiveness**

**Honor is more than what you say.
It's what you do, and what you decide in your heart.**

- **Parents: Love and Boundaries**

Become the person you are trying to raise.
