John 16:7 (ESV) Acts 19:1-2 (ESV)

What you believe determines what you receive

Absolutes Convictions Preferences

ru'ach – a wind, breath, a violent exhalation, blast of breath. / Genesis 1:2 (NIV) pneuma – a current of air, blast of breath, a strong breeze. / Matthew 3:11 (ESV)

Four Ways of the Wind:

- Wind is unseen / John 14:16-17 (NIV)
- Wind is unpredictable / John 3:8 (ESV)

God is predictable in His nature, but unpredictable in His nurture

- Wind is unstoppable / Acts 1:8 (ESV)
- Wind is uplifting / 1 Corinthians 2:9-10 (ESV)

2 Corinthians 13:14 (ESV)

God the Father loves me. God the Son saves me. God the Holy Spirit is with me.

Holy Spirit Challenge:

- Release your fears and misperceptions.
- Renew your commitment to God.
- Receive an intimate friendship with the Holy Spirit.
