1 Samuel 25:1-43

Nabal: 'Fool' – described as 'harsh' and 'badly behaved'

Abigail: 'The Father's Joy' – described as 'discerning' and 'beautiful'

A Fool's Game: Stepping Away from God's Call on your life.

A Worthy Walk: Remembering Who God's Called you to be, and walking it out.

Challenge: Cultivate a Lifestyle that helps you Remember Who God's Called you to be and enables you to walk it out daily.

Discussion Questions

- 1) What aspects of the story of David, Nabal and Abigail do you relate with the most?
- 2) How have you ever 'played a fool's game' in the past? What are the current temptations now?
- 3) What are 1-3 ways you can cultivate a lifestyle that helps you remember who God has called you to be?
- 4) In the past, who have been the people who have helped you with "the worthy walk?" Who are some people now that can help you walk out this worthy walk on a daily basis?
- 5) What's your plan for the next time you end up playing "A Fool's Game?" What will you do first? Who will you tell first?
