

Abide: A Study in 1 John Idol Antidote

#### **Sermon Notes**

**Big Idea:** What's the difference between knowing about God and knowing God? What changes take place in your life when you have a genuine relationship with God? How can you be assured that your relationship with God is real? Let's discover what it means to abide.

# Can you know that you really know God? Abide: to stay or remain.

### Four Keys to Knowing God:

- 1) Embrace the Facts about Jesus.
- 2) Experience Friendship with Jesus.
- 3) Enjoy Fellowship with Christians.
- 4) Evidence of Fruitfulness because of Jesus.

#### 1 John 5:1-21 (ESV)

If following Jesus feels <u>heavy</u>... you're likely not abiding. If following Jesus feels <u>inviting</u>... you're likely abiding.

Idols <u>promise</u> things that only God can delivery.

#### **Identifying Idols:**

- 1) What gets your attention?
- 2) What are you afraid of losing?
- 3) Where do you get your identity?
- 4) Where do you go for satisfaction?
- 5) What do you make sacrifices for?

- **4)** Read 1 John 5:16-17. How often do you pray for struggling friends who want to overcome the grip of sin in their lives? What have the results been?
- **5)** Read 1 John 5:21. Why do you think John ended this letter with this warning? What are some idols you've identified in your life? How can you apply the *Idol Antidote* this week?
