Big Idea: Everybody enjoys a good love song... but do the lyrics ever truly come alive? God's Word redefines attraction, dating, intimacy, conflict, depth, and faithfulness. With Jesus at the center, as we trust His leading, our relationships can work. It's time to trust God's lyrics for your Love Song.

Do you trust that God's ways are right, good and better?

Song of Solomon 8:5-14 (NIV)

- 1) Faithful Love is Possessive.
- 2) Faithful Love is Persevering.

Covenant Relationships surrender rights and assume responsibility.

Convenient Relationships protect rights and shirk responsibility.

- 3) Faithful Love is Priceless.
- 4) Faithful Love is Protective.
- 5) Faithful Love is Peaceful.

Love Song Theme: Love is a Choice.

The only way to experience a True Love Song is to experience True Love in Jesus.

Discussion Questions

- 1) What impacted you the most from this week's message? Encouraged you? Challenged you?
- 2) Share how you have experienced faithful love from others (Possessive, Persevering, Priceless, Protective, Peaceful). Which aspect of faithful love spoke to you the most? Why?
- 3) Have you ever been in a 'convenient' relationship before (could have been non-romantic)? Explain. Share your personal description of what a 'covenant' relationship should be like.
- 4) Share how your experience of Jesus' love has given you the ability to genuinely love others.
- 5) Choose five loving things you can do for someone you love this week – then do them!
- 6) Read The Song of Solomon again, praying through each truth God brings to mind as you reflect on this series. Journal your thoughts and prayers.
