## **Sermon Notes**

**Big Idea:** Many times when Jesus spoke He told stories. Stories of how to live, how to love, and how to honor God. Let's unpack these simple stories together to discover how to maximize our lives in God's Kingdom.

Parable: A simple story designed to illustrate how life in God's Kingdom works.

Matthew 13:34-35 (ESV) Luke 15:1; 11-32 (ESV)

God's address never changes: You'll always find Him at the end of yourself.

Four Steps to Reckless Love:

- RETURN

- REPENT

Luke 5:32 (NLT)

Spiritual Maturity: Repenting quicker than you used to.

- RE-EARN

As a Child of God, you don't get what you <u>deserve</u>, you get what your Father <u>decides</u> and <u>declares</u>!

- RECEIVE

Acts 3:19-20 (NASB)

- REFUSE to RESENT
