Song of Solomon 1:1-2:1-7 (NIV)

The Proper order of Faithful Attraction:

- 1) Spiritual Attraction – Love, Honor, and Serve God.
- 2) Emotional Attraction – Friendship, Respect and Affirmation.

If you don't like what you're seeing in your spouse,
evaluate what you're saying to your spouse.

- 3) Physical Attraction - Recognizing True Beauty

Discussion Questions

- 1) What impacted you the most from this week's message? Encouraged you? Challenged you?
- 2) Describe a spiritually attractive person. How spiritually attractive do you consider yourself? What can you do to grow in this area?
- 3) Describe an emotionally attractive person. How emotionally attractive do you consider yourself? What can you do to grow in this area?
- 4) If single: Write down the character qualities that you are looking for in a spouse. Pray that you would become the type of person who can match those qualities.
- 5) If married: Begin to affirm your spouse toward who God is calling them to be. Pray with them in regards to who you both want to become to best serve one another. What needs to change in order for you to become your spouse's 'number one fan'?
