Five Ingredients to Finding your Purpose

- 1) Love Others / Ephesians 4:1-4 (ESV)**
- 2) Discover and Develop Your Spiritual Gifts / 1 Peter 4:10 (ESV)**
- 3) Recognize your natural talents and abilities.**
- 4) Harness your experiences. / 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 (ESV)**
- 5) Press in to your passions and burdens.**

A healthy vision is a combination of what *could be* and what *should be*.
