Sermon Notes

Big Idea: When the people of God courageously follow the plan of God, they begin to walk in the fullness of His promises. This truth is illustrated most powerfully in the book of Joshua, as this 'next-up' leader prepares God's people to step into and occupy the Promised Land after 40 years of wandering. Are you ready to step into your promised life? It's time to take new ground!

Take New Ground:

- <u>Identify</u> your next, right step.
- Prayerfully make a plan.
- **Share** that plan with others.
- <u>Courageously</u> move forward.

How to Deal with Darkness:

- We need to <u>Explain</u> it. <u>Lies</u> of the Devil <u>Lust</u> of the Flesh <u>Lure</u> of the World Where are you most susceptible to the <u>schemes</u> of darkness?
- We need to <u>Expose</u> it. R<u>ecognize</u>, R<u>epent</u>, R<u>estore</u>, R<u>enew</u>
 <u>Unconfessed</u> sin will destroy you! Do you <u>repent</u> faster than you used to?
- We need to <u>Eradicate</u> it. Three Steps: P<u>assion</u>, P<u>lan</u>, P<u>erson</u>
