## **Sermon Notes**

Exodus 20:1-4, 7-8, 12-17 (ESV)

Matthew 5:21-22a, 27-28 (ESV)

Malachi 3:8-10 (ESV)

• It's not tithing if it's not 10%. Not giving God 10% is stealing.

Proverbs 11:1 (ESV)

· God hates falsehood.

Integrity is choosing your thoughts and actions based on values (principles) rather than on personal gain.

- Mark 10:17-22 (ESV)
- Integrity is who you are when no one is looking.
- 1 Chronicles 29:17a (NLT)

Generosity has nothing to do with possessions or the giving of possessions and everything to do with posture.

• 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (ESV)

The key is to embrace His values:

- 1. Acknowledge Him
  - o Proverbs 3:6 (ESV)
- 2. Agree with Him
  - Repent = change your mind
  - o Matthew 3:8 (ESV)
  - o In my being and in my doing, I'm going to say the same things that You are saying.
  - o Let your values inform your actions and your being inform your doing.

Mark 10:23-27 (ESV)
