Three Kinds of Faith

1) Dead Faith

- **Lip Service without Lifestyle**
- **Leaves without Fruit**

2) Deceived Faith

- **Information without Transformation**
- **No Love for Jesus**
- **Rebellion without Repentance**

Spiritually: Death Begins when Repentance Ends

3) Dynamic Faith

Matthew 16:24 (ESV)

Dynamic Faith: Trusting Jesus + Following (Obeying) Jesus = Becoming like Jesus
