Big Idea: Jesus' first sermon was designed to help his followers redefine what a relationship with God was truly about. The blessed life can be measured by how well you display certain Christ-like qualities. Jesus knows that only those with courageous faith can endure the unique blessing of persecution.

The Christian life is not primarily about what you're doing, but who you're becoming.
