

Abide: A Study in 1 John The Anointing

Sermon Notes

Big Idea: What's the difference between knowing about God and knowing God? What changes take place in your life when you have a genuine relationship with God? How can you be assured that your relationship with God is real? Let's discover what it means to abide.

Can you know that you <u>really</u> know God? Abide: to stay or <u>remain</u>.

Four Keys to Knowing God:

- 1) Embrace the Facts about Jesus.
- 2) Experience Fellowship with Jesus.
- 3) Enjoy Friendship with Christians.
- 4) Evidence of Fruitfulness because of Jesus.

1 John 2:18-28 (ESV)

1 John 3:1-3 (ESV)

- **3)** Read 1 John 2:18-25. Have you had any experiences with people you considered heretical or anti-Christs? How was their message about Jesus wrong or off in your opinion?
- **4)** Read 1 John 2:26-29. Have you ever experienced what you would consider *The Anointing*? Which of the four *Supernatural* results are most frequent for you? Which one(s) are you longing to experience more often?
- **5)** Read 1 John 3:1-3. When's the last time you spent time dwelling on God's love and goodness over your life? Explain. Will you do the *Abide Assignment*? When?
