

## Sermon Notes

**Big Idea:** God is on a mission to change the world. Unfortunately, His Church is often reluctant to join Him. The story of Jonah is a prophetic wake-up call to the current state of Christianity to stop fleeing from God's purpose and Presence, and get back on mission.
