## **Sermon Notes**

**Big Idea:** Many times when Jesus spoke He told stories. Stories of how to live, how to love, and how to honor God. Let's unpack these simple stories together to discover how to maximize our lives in God's Kingdom.

Parable: A simple story <u>STORY</u> to illustrate how life in God's <u>KINGDOM</u> works.

Matthew 25:14-28 (ESV)

What is a talent?

Talent = 75 lb gold

20 years wages

## **Three Talent Takeaways:**

- 1. All were given something according to their **ABILITY**.
- 2. The servants had been around the master long enough to <u>UNDERSTAND</u> how the master operated.
- 3. If you are FAITHFUL with what you are given, you can be TRUSTED with more.
