

Galatians: Let Grace Work Good Enough?

## **Sermon Notes**

**Big Idea:** How can you tell the difference between engaging God as a religion, and enjoying God through a relationship. To sum it up in one word - the difference is GRACE. The Book of Galatians helps Christians eradicate a religious approach to God from our lives, so that we can pursue a joyous relationship with Him. Let's learn to *Let Grace Work*.

Religion: Trying to be Godly without God.

## **Two Key Questions:**

**Galatians 1:1-12; 2:20 (NIV)** 

- 1. Where is the 'Trap of Religion' holding me back?
- 2. How is a 'Relationship of Grace' actively setting me free?

Religion says, "I'm not <u>good</u> enough." Grace says, "I'm not <u>good</u> enough."

Religion says, "<u>Do</u>." Grace says, "<u>Done</u>!"

Religion says, "ought" and "should." Grace says, "finished" and "complete."

Religion focuses on what we can do <u>for</u> God. Grace focuses on what God has done <u>for</u> us.

Religion focuses on what we can do <u>for</u> God. Grace focuses on what we can do <u>with</u> God.

Religion focuses on the <u>outward</u>. Grace focuses on the <u>inward</u>.

Religion makes <u>rules</u>. Grace makes room. Religion <u>isolates</u> from the culture. Grace <u>infiltrates</u> the culture.

Religion says the <u>method</u> is sacred. Grace says the <u>message</u> is sacred.

Religion seeks to <u>protect</u> itself. Grace embraces <u>change</u> and risk.

Religion points <u>inward</u>. Grace points <u>outward</u>.

Religion says, "<u>Behave</u>, Believe, Belong." Grace says, "Belong, Believe, <u>Behave</u>."

Religion's fruit is a judgmental heart and a <u>critical</u> spirit. Grace's fruit is an open heart and a <u>generous</u> spirit.

Religion produces shame and <u>condemnation</u>. Grace produces sorrow and <u>conviction</u>.
