James 5:1-12 (ESV)

When it comes to Wealth:

1) Don't hoard it greedily but steward it wisely.

Ownership

- I do not belong to the Lord
- Nothing I have belongs to the Lord
- I deserve all that I have
- I only answer to myself

Stewardship

- I belong to the Lord
- Everything belongs to the Lord
- All I have is a gift
- I am the Lord's Steward
- 2) Don't handle it deceitfully but distribute it honestly.
- 3) Don't spend it selfishly but share it generously.

When it comes to Waiting:

- 1) Trust God's Process
- 2) Honor God's People
- 3) Embrace God's Promises
