Luke 12:48 (b) (ESV) Everyone to whom much was given, of him much will be required, and from him to whom they entrusted much, they will demand the more.

"You get to heaven based on what Jesus did for you, but your reward is based on what you did with what He gave you!"

Acts 20:24 (NIV) However, I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace.

1 Cor 9:24-27 (NIV) Do you not know that in a race all the runners compete, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. 25 Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. 26 So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air. 27 But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.
