Revelation 7:9-10 (ESV) After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all (*every*) tribes and (*every*) peoples and (*every*) languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, ¹⁰and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"
