2. What was the issue the Pharisees had with Jesus and His disciples in Luke 5?
3. What point is Jesus making with the illustration of the new patch on old clothes?
4. What does the "new wine and old wineskins" teach us about Jesus and our old ways of thinking?

Heart Level Reflection Questions

1. What is something in your life you know Jesus is asking you to let go of—but you're holding onto because it feels familiar or safe?
2. Where might you be trying to "add Jesus" into your life instead of allowing Him to truly change it?
3. When have you resisted change in your spiritual life, and what was underneath that resistance?
4. What part of following Jesus currently feels uncomfortable or stretching for you—and why?
5. If you fully trusted Jesus with your life, what would need to look different starting today?
