3. Do you believe God can use ordinary people like you to make an eternal impact? Why or why not?
4. Is your relationship with Jesus personal and surrendered, or have you mostly stayed close to Christian things without truly following him?
5. Who is one person in your life that God may be calling you to bring closer to Jesus this week?
