## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is the difference between not judging and not condemning in verse 37? Why are these both mentioned?
2. The parable of the blind leading the blind warns us of who (or what) we follow. What “blind things” do you find yourself being influenced by?
3. What examples do you have of someone helping to remove a speck from your eye in a helpful manner?
4. Why do you think Jesus shares the parable about blind leading the blind in this section where it feels somewhat out of place?
5. How does remembering that we will be judged based on how we show grace to others affect your interactions with people?

### Heart- Level Reflection Questions

1. Why is it so easy for us to see specks in other people’s lives?
2. What practices do you have in your life to help you identify the “planks in your eyes?”
3. What is the healthiest way to handle a “speck” in someone’s eye? Is Jesus telling us just to ignore it?
4. What are the dangers of Christians being hypocritical when it comes to our judging of others?
5. From verses 37 and 38, which of those topics are hardest for you to handle like Jesus tells you to?
