"Whenever the devil throws any type of test at you, it's to test the Level of your *Emotional Intelligence* according to the Word of God."




When it comes to the emotions, they operate like an old thermometer.

The 3 states of ego are: the Child, Parent & Adult.





#### **CHILD**

contains all natural feelings, needs, impulses, and potentialities of an infant. It also contains creative, manipulative, intuitive capacities as well as feelings and behaviors learnt during childhood like compliance, procrastination, anger



#### **ADULT**

When a person is living in the here and now, gathering facts, computing them, and acting on the basis of facts, rather than on the basis of parental tradition or childhood feelings, they are in the adult ego state.
