

STUDENT BIBLE STUDY GUIDE: HEZEKIAH'S PASSOVER (LESSON 2: RENEWING RELATIONSHIPS)

2 Chronicles 20:1-5, 2 Chronicles 30:1-5

This lesson explores the renewal of relationships, both with God and between people, using the historical account of King Hezekiah's Passover celebration.

Lesson Context

- Division and Conflict: Families, friends, and communities can become estranged due to external circumstances like moving away or internal conflict.
- Historical Background: The united monarchy of Israel divided into the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah in 931 BC, during the reign of Rehoboam. These two kingdoms were hostile toward each other for nearly 200 years.
- **Hezekiah's Reign (approx. 715–685 BC):** When Hezekiah took the throne, the temple was physically in disrepair and spiritually defiled⁵. He initiated a restoration project to purify the temple so the people could worship the Lord faithfully again.
