# Christian Science | First Church of Christ, Scientists

#### DATE **FOUNDER**

▶ Mary Baker Eddy (1821-1910)

Church of Christ, Scientist founded in 1879

#### LOCATION

▶ Headquarters in Boston, Massachusetts

### WHO IS GOD?

- According to Mrs. Eddy, God is an impersonal Principle of life, truth, love, intelligence, and spirit.
- God is all that truly exists; matter is an illusion.

### WHO IS JESUS?

- According to Mrs. Eddy, Jesus was not the <u>Christ</u>, but a man who displayed the Christ idea. ("Christ" means <u>perfection</u>, *not* a person.)
- ▶ He was not God, and God can never become man or flesh.
- ▶ He did not <u>suffer</u> and could not <u>suffer</u> for sins.
- ▶ He did not die on the cross.
- ▶ He was not resurrected physically.
- ▶ He will not literally come back.

# WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

- ▶ Mrs. Eddy defines the "Holy Ghost" as "Divine Science" (that is, the teaching of Christian Science).
- It is an impersonal power.

### **HOW TO BE SAVED**

- Sin, evil, sickness, and death are not real.
- Humanity is already eternally saved.

# WHAT HAPPENS AFTER DEATH

- Death is not real.
- Heaven and hell are states of mind.
- ▶ The way to reach heaven is by <u>attaining harmony</u> (oneness with God).

# **OTHER BELIEFS AND PRACTICES**

- ▶ Members use Christian Science "practitioners" (authorized professional healers who "treat" supposed illnesses for a fee) instead of doctors.
- Healing comes through realizing one cannot really be sick or hurt and that the body cannot be ill, suffer pain, or die (since matter is an illusion).
- ▶ Attracts followers by claims of miraculous healing.
- ▶ Publishes *Christian Science Monitor* newspaper.
- ▶ Established Reading Rooms and branches of The First Church of Christ, Scientists, located in around 1,200 cities.

### WHO IS GOD?

- ▶ Scientology does not <u>define</u> God or a Supreme Being.
- ▶ However, it <u>rejects</u> the biblical description of God.
- Everyone is a "thetan," an immortal spirit with unlimited powers over its own universe (but not all are aware of this).

### WHO IS JESUS?

- ▶ Jesus is <u>rarely</u> mentioned in Scientology.
- ▶ He was not the Creator.
- ▶ He did not reach the level of "operating thetan" (i.e., being in control of supernatural powers and cleared from mental defects).
- ▶ He did not die for <u>sins</u>.

# WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

▶ The Holy Spirit is <u>not part</u> of this belief.

### **HOW TO BE SAVED**

- ▶ There is no sin or need to repent.
- ▶ Thetans are reborn time and time again in new bodies through a process called "<u>assumption</u>" which is analogous to reincarnation.
- ▶ Salvation is freedom from reincarnation.
- ▶ <u>Engrams</u> (hang-ups in the form of subconscious "mental image pictures") are painful and debilitating; as they accumulate, people move further away from their true identity.
- ▶ One must work on his "engrams" with an "<u>auditor</u>" to achieve the state of "<u>clear</u>," then progress up the "<u>bridge to total freedom</u>."
- ▶ Auditing is a <u>one-on-one</u> session with a Scientology counselor or auditor.
- ▶ Through auditing, it is said that people can solve their problems and <u>free themselves</u> of engrams.
- Once an area of concern has been identified, the auditor asks the individual specific questions about it, in order to help him or her eliminate the engram, and uses the E-meter to confirm that the engram's "charge" has been dissipated and the engram has in fact been cleared.

### WHAT HAPPENS AFTER DEATH

- ▶ Hell is a myth.
- ▶ People who get clear of engrams become "operating thetans" (having "a state of <u>complete spiritual</u> freedom").

# **OTHER BELIEFS AND PRACTICES**

- Members observe the birth of Hubbard and the anniversary of the publication of Dianetics.
- ▶ <u>Controversy</u> follows the group worldwide.
- ▶ Time magazine and Reader's Digest have published damaging exposés.
- ▶ Members believe that the practice of <u>psychiatry</u> is destructive and abusive and must be abolished.
