Embrace God's Design for Marriage – Pray that God will help you see your spouse as a partner, not an opponent, and embrace His design for unity.

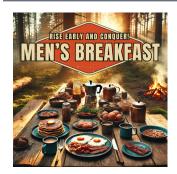
Build Up with Your Words - Ask God to help you speak lifegiving words that heal and restore, especially during moments of tension.
