Life Group Questions

Getting to Know You:

1. Have you ever tried to share something with someone, but they distorted what you said? How did you respond?

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read John 3:16, Acts 2:38, Romans 1:16-17, Romans 10:9-10, 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, 2 Corinthians 5:21, and Galatians 1:1-7. What are the essentials of the Gospel, and how does one receive it? What does the Gospel reveal about God? In what ways is the Gospel powerful and transformative?
- 2. Read Matthew 24:24, 2 Corinthians 11:12-15, Galatians 1:8-9, 1 Timothy 6:3-5, Ephesians 6:10-18, 1 Peter 5:8 and 1 John 4:1-3. What are the different ways Satan uses to attack believers? How can we identify and respond to his assaults?
- 3. Read Isaiah 30:8-10, Galatians 1:6-10, 1 Timothy 6:5, 2 Timothy 4:3-4, and 2 Peter 2:15. What are some significant ways the Gospel has been distorted? Why would people want to change this great news? What does this reveal about our human nature?

1. How has the Gospel impacted the way you see yourself and the world? What has been the most significant change you have seen in your life as a result of the Gospel?
