

Getting to Know You:

- 1. If you were asked to build a parade float that best represented your life and ride on it through town, what material would you choose, what props would you carry, and what symbols would be featured?
- 2. This is our week of prayer and fasting and the time we complete our series and look to Jesus' destination of the cross and His victory there over death. What transformation has this series made on you? How has it enriched your appreciation for the symbolism of the cross?

Digging Deeper

- 1. Read Exodus 12:5-15 and consider how Jesus fulfilled this feast, then discuss the metaphoric ways we can apply the Passover and similar Old Testament symbolism to our lives today. Use 1 Peter 1:18-19, 1 Corinthians 5:6-8, and Hebrews 13:11-16 for inspiration in your discussion.
- 2. Jesus was God, but He was also fully man. Read Luke 9:51-53, Mark 8:31-33, and John 12:27 and compare it with John 12:27-33 and Luke 22:41-44, then discuss the tension between Jesus' determination to fulfill the will of God and the apprehension he felt. How could knowing Jesus struggled to accomplish God's calling encourage you in times of weakness?
- 3. Read the prophecies in Zechariah 9:9 and Isaiah 53:2-3 then compare them with Jesus' fulfillment in Luke 2:7, John 1:46, and Matthew 13:54-58. What do you believe God's purpose is for Jesus' first coming? What significance does this have for you?

Taking it Home

- 1. How does the apparent conflict in Jesus' calling to the cross inspire you about your struggles to follow God's purpose for your life?
- 2. Read Hebrews 4:15-16 and consider the new depth and quality of a relationship we can experience with God on this side of the cross. How does it make you feel? What can you do to show your appreciation for what He has done?

Humility is putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve.

DAY 1

Read Mark 9:35

This month is all about humility, putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve. We feel like having things our way, all the time! But Jesus tells us to do the opposite. We need to serve others before serving ourselves. To serve simply means to pay attention to the people around you and find ways to help.

Write out the words Jesus gave to his followers from today's verse in big block letters on a piece of paper. Decorate the page any way you'd like. Then cut the paper apart into four or five large pieces to create a puzzle. Shuffle the pieces into a stack. Ask a younger sibling or friend to put the puzzle together. Then read the verse aloud and tell them what it means to you.

DAY 2


Read Mark 10:45

Jesus gathered His friends for their last supper and showed them how to serve by getting down on his hands and knees to wash their dirty feet. This act of service, something usually done by the lowest ranking servant in a home, painted a picture of how He wanted them to treat others. Jesus knew that in just a few hours, he would be arrested, tried, convicted, and sentenced to death. Right up until the very end of his time on earth, Jesus chose to serve. And by doing so, He set an example for His disciples and for all of us.

So how can YOU serve? In the space below, write down the names of three people you see most every day. Next to each name, write one way you can serve them this week. Then pray and ask Jesus to help you serve just as He served, with a good attitude and a willingness to put others first.
